### A competition for transplant recipients of all ages (from 9 years)

With competitions in many different disciplines from skiing and snowboarding to cross-country skiing and curling, the Winter World Transplant Games provides challenges and excitement in equal quantities.

## A live-in camp for transplanted children from 8-15 years

The Nicholas Green Camp is an amazing opportunity for transplanted children to gain confidence and independence, learn to ski or snowboard and discover the mountain environment. Children are fully-supervised 24 hours a day by experienced camp counsellors and qualified nurses, supported by a team of enthusiastic volunteers and translators. A transplant doctor oversees the medical team. Unaccompanied children are welcome and can be collected at Geneva airport. Ski equipment, ski clothing and ski lessons are all provided. The Nicholas Cup slalom race, in memory of Nicholas Green, will take place at the end of the camp and this race is also open to registered accompanying children.
